The children have just finished the school year and are now looking forward to the summer break. However, the last several months have been hard, uncertain, and a bit worrisome. There were several times the school would send the children back home because of safety concerns. Due to the hostilities, there was speculation that the water had been poisoned and attempts had been made to demolish the water pipes. We were informed that the local hospital had taken on gun-fire but only windows were broken and no fatalities. The days are calm but at night shots can be heard. Praise be to God that through all of these events, our children have remained safe. Locals around the orphanage have started to rebuild their basements to seek safety and protection. The orphanage is being proactive in rebuilding the abandoned well in case water supply becomes a major issue.

Many people have been killed in Donetsk, therefore an increase of children in need is expected. The orphanage has already recently welcomed a boy from Donetsk. We hope to get more information on him soon to share with you. Continue to pray for peace, safety, and sponsorship for our children.
