**Just received an update from Pastor
Leonid through his daughter Lilya:**

I want to thank all of you for your generous hearts. We all thank you for extra money that you decided to send to us.

This year started hard for us. Six of our children are in the hospital now. I told you that we had here epidemic of hepatitis A. We prayed and we didn't know where to get money for medicine. Papa talked with his friends from western Ukraine and they told us that they can give us food but they don't have money, so they brought us food but it was still not enough to save for medicine. Then Mr. Behzad, you called me and told us that you added some extra money, that was answer on our prayers. I don't remember if I told you but for 1 child we needed 3000 gr. for medicine. For example, 1 injection of the medication costs 130 gr. Each child needs 20 of these injections plus other expenditures.



At the end of January we accepted 4 families of refugees from Avdeivka. Now we have 22 refugees living on our property. They are of different ages. They don't have a place to live as their houses were demolished. They are people without hope, as they call themselves, but we know that God is a God of second chances.

More News Just Yesterday: First of all, I want to praise God that we have armistice. It's not real because we know that the enemy still continues bombing our cities but at least not as often as it was before. We still have soldiers with guns and tanks on our streets. In our hospital, we have tents for wounded soldiers. Our hospital became a war hospital, but we believe that soon they all will go home. Secondly, we took 10 more refugee children with their parents and they live with our children. I'm sending you a report and exchange rate for February. The rate was 16.50 grivnas to one dollar, now it is 21. Every day they change it. It is different all the time. Banks do not have dollars, they only give grivnas. Prices are crazy. For example: 2 months ago, sugar was 8 gr now it is 25 gr. It is the same with rice, oil, and other products, but it's ok we can live. There is talk of raising prices for electricity and gas again, that can be a major problem. Please continue to pray. Thank you for all you do! We need you.
